Funding Research

The Impact of Healing Touch on Oncology Patients

Richard Schraeder, M.D., Rosemary Menton, OCN, BSN, HTP-A, and Patricia Johnson, BSN.University of Maryland, St. Joseph Medical Center, Cancer Institute.

The research team is studying the effects of stress levels in patients receiving radiation therapy. Cortisol levels are assessed based on saliva, blood pressure and pulse. Two groups of participants are monitored and compared, those receiving weekly Healing Touch sessions and those who do not.

Effectiveness of Complimentary Therapies to Reduce Pain in Spinal Fusion Patients

Karen Sacks, MSN, PNP. Nemours/Alfred I DuPont Hospital for Children.

The research focuses on the use of Healing Touch and Hypnosis for pain reduction versus the standard of care for spinal fusion patients. Anxiety levels, pain scores, cortisol levels, changes in mean arterial pressure, heart rate variability, and narcotic use will be used to determine the efficacy of Healing Touch.

Funding Education

Healing Touch in Nepal

Tim McConville, HTCP/I, is continuing efforts to establish a Healing Touch Program in Nepal. Tim's visit to Nepal included teaching a Level 4 class as well as supporting Aparna Bhatta in her efforts to bring additional classes to Nepal. With the addition of more Healing Touch Practitioners, there is potential to provide Healing Touch to the public in free clinics.

Funding Service

Homeless Veterans Stand Downs

HTWF designated funds to HTPA for support of Military Stand Downs in four locations in Texas. HTWF and HTPA work hand in hand with coordinator, Susan Russell, HTCP/I, to provide Healing Touch to Homeless Veterans. A typical Stand Down includes Healing Touch volunteers providing fifteen to twenty-five veterans with Healing Touch services. One volunteer states, "It is a wonderful feeling to see veterans smiling and experiencing less pain and stress as they leave."

Service one step at a time

In 2014 we were able to build upon the success of new events introduced in 2013. Online Raffle funds increased by 73%, this came as the result of offering higher value items and tighter alignment with the interests of our donors. For the first time, a new race was added to the Worldwide Conference which increased the Heel to Heal revenue by 61%! These two new activities increased the overall funds raised by 64% over 2013 accounting for ~ 50% of funds raised!
