Advancing the Work of Janet Mentgen and Healing Touch in Japan

Executive Summary

Over the past 6 years, *Healing Touch Japan* has shared Healing Touch with over 600 individuals by providing classes, seminars, conference lectures and clinics. Our mission is to provide opportunities for anyone interested in Japan to learn and experience Healing Touch in their native language while working to advance the work of Janet Mentgen internationally.

Healing Touch Japan, through support from the Healing Touch Worldwide Foundation, successfully provided Healing Touch classes, an Introduction to Healing Touch seminar, and special lectures across Japan between September and December, 2015.

Six Healing Touch Program classes, including three Level 1, two Level 2 and one Level 3, were taught at three different universities within Japan. The first hospital presentation of Healing Touch and Integrative Medicine was presented by Rumi Hashimoto, MSN, RN, HTCP/I, at Yokohama Minami Kyousai Hospital in Yokohama, Japan. The University of Occupational and Environmental Health in Kitakyushu, Japan, also hosted an Introduction to Healing Touch, attended by many nurses and educators. A special lecture for nursing students at Yokohama Soei University, School of Nursing, focusing on the integration of Healing Touch into nursing practice, was well received by nursing students and professors in attendance. Through the various classes and outreach events, the total reach is estimated at 227 participants.


